Scope of the REC

- The FTR, REC is responsible for reviewing research that includes persons and animals as sources of information, that is conducted by undergraduate students, postgraduate students and members of staff at the Faculty of Theology and Religion at the University of Pretoria. The FTR, REC obtains applications broadly in two ways:
- 2 Staff members responsible for undergraduate modules *submit declarations of ethical intent*, if they want students to do site visits, interview members of faith communities and interview students or staff of the University of Pretoria.
- 3 Students, staff and associated researchers (research associates of the FTR) conducting research that utilises people and or animals as sources of information, must *submit an online application for approval* via the Research and Ethics section on the UP staff and student Portal.
