Mzansi schoolboys haul gold and silver

TUKS High School pupil Tshenolo Lemao spearheaded a gold-silver haul for South Africa in the boys' 100m at the world under-18 championships in a wet Nairobi last night.

He led from the start to clock 10.57sec, with countryman Retshidisitswe Mlenga chasing hard for second place in 10.61, edging prerace favourite Tyreke Wilson of Jamaica (10.65), the highest ranked of the sprinters in the field.

"I knew the conditions would be tough," a beaming Lemao said afterwards. "But I told myself I needed to stay strong, stay focused and just go, just go." — David Isaacson
