preparation squad announced
by Athletics South Africa for
the 2018 1AAF World Indoor
Championships.
Manyonga, who was named
Sports Star of the Year at last
week's SA Sports Awards, leads
a powerful men's long jump
trio which also includes World
Championships bronze medallist
Ruswahl Samaai and former
African champion Zarck Visser.

African champion Zarck Visser. Former national 100m record holder Henricho Bruintjies, meanwhile, carries a strong sprint contingent which also features powerhouse speedster Emile Erasmus and joint SA women's 100m record holder Carina Horn.

The other members of the preparation squad are shot put giant Orazio Cremona and US-based distance runner Dominique Scott-Efurd.

"Well done to all athletes who have been named in the preparation squad, but the door is not closed yet for other athletes," said ASA president Aleck Skhosana.

"We are expecting to send a strong team to the IAAF World Indoor Championships, which will offer another opportunity for our nation's top athletes to prepare for the Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, Australia in August."

The next IAAF World Indoor Championships will be held in Birmingham, England in the first week of March 2018.
