



Now Simbine sets out to collect titles

Fastest man in Africa hopes Tuks turf will boost his times

The fastest man in Africa, Akani Simbine, will start his 2018 season on March 8 at the second of three Athletix Grand Prix Meetings at the Bestmed Tuks Stadium in Pretoria.

Simbine firmly secured the title of "Fastest man in Africa" in 2016 when he clocked 9.89sec in the 100m in Hungary.

Fast times however are no longer his only driving force. Simbine wants titles, global titles and 2018 is the year in which the 24-year-old is looking to start his collection.

His first target will be the gold medal in the 100m at the Commonwealth Games in Australia in April.

The journey to chasing those titles starts at Tuks, where he has run three of his fastest 100m times and his best 200m time.

"2017 was a disappointing year for me. I had much bigger expectations than the fifth place finish at the World Championships. I wanted a medal, but was hampered by an ongoing hip injury," says Simbine.

"I train here. I like this track. It is fast and you are always guaranteed fast times."

It was here that he became the first South African to do the sub-10sec and sub 20sec double in the 100m and 200m, in March last year. - Athletics South Africa
