

Bosman in top form for Two Oceans

She is a favourite

Two Oceans Marathon women's contender Charne Bosman will take to the road in the race on Saturday in tip-top form having bagged two titles already this year.

Earlier in the year, Bosman captured back-to-back wins in the Johnson Crane and the Tuks Bestmed marathons.

She makes a return after missing last year's Two Oceans to focus on the Comrades Marathon which she won.

"I do not want to put pressure on myself. I don't go out with the mind set of trying to beat anyone because if I do that then I will lose focus on my own race," Bosman said.

"Last year was good for me and I am looking forward racing again on Chapman's Peak."

Bosman, 42, could be in with a chance after defending champion, Belarusian Maryna Damantsevich, withdrew.
