He was signed on a two-year contract from Juth FC in his homeland, and at the time was competing for a striking berth with Divo Sibisi and current caretaker coach Fadlu Davids

His only appearance came a month after signing, but he could not command a regular spot and when coach lan Palmer left in January 2012, he faded away He was then involved in a car accident
