AmaZulu, who clawed their way back into contention by thumping Jomo Cosmos in midweek, travel to troubled FC Cape Town. The Cape side find themselves in an abyss after losing to already promoted Thanda Royal Zulu, with Magesi's surprise 6-0 win over Real Kings moving them ahead of

FC Cape Town.

Stellenbosch should fancy their chances when they host already relegated Santos, while Eagles visit Spurs in a clash where a draw will not be sufficient for either side.
