## Ajax win a match

**AJAX** Cape Town beat nine-man Chippa and snapped their four-match winless run with a 1-0 victory at Milpark on Saturday.

An invigorated winger Thabo Mosadi was the man of the moment for the Urban Warriors, with the star man scoring the winning goal and tormenting the Chilli Boys – leading to red cards for Zitha Macheke and goalkeeper Daniel Akpeyi.

The three points moved Stanley Menzo's manne out of the relegation zone for the weekend and ease some of the pressure on the Dutch boss.

The sides traded chances early in the first half, with Chippa – coming into the game unbeaten in their last 10 outings – creating the better opportunities.

But it was Ajax's Mosadi who found the back of the net for the second time in as many matches as he lashed home Grant Margeman's inviting ball into the roof of the net.

Mosadi's strike partner Tashreeq Morris was denied at point-blank by Akpeyi as the Cape side went for the kill.

But the Chilli Boys were their own undoing as Macheke hacked down the lively Mosadi as the ex-Philippi team went into the break a goal and a man down.

Chippa didn't stop playing, though, as they went for an equaliser.

Ajax sat back and tried to pick them off on the counter.

And that's when Mosadi got his chance late in the game.

But faced with a one-on-one, keeper Akpeyi brought down the former AmaTuks winger and was given his marching orders in time added-on.
