lands Park this past Saturday. Goals from Petrus Ngebo and Phoka Mofokeng sealed maximum points for the Lions of the North from Gauteng at the Harry Gwala Stadium, while Zimbabwean striker Cleopas Dube netted the consolation goal for the home
