Local hero scoops two PSL titles

Aubrey Ngoma took home the Absa Premiership Midfielder of the Season and Telkom Knockout Player of the Tournament awards.

Hammanskraal born soccer star Aubrey Ngoma was one of the biggest winners in Monday's Absa Premier League awards.

The event was held at the Sandton convention centre.

Ngoma was voted the Absa Premiership Midfielder of the Season and Telkom Knockout Player of the Tournament following his good season with Cape Town City.

This comes after he helped the club finish third in the Premier

Soccer League last season.

He was also instrumental when the Cape side outmatched Supersport United back in December to claim the Telkom Knockout Cup.

In a club statement, Ngoma thanked his teammates for their support and motivation.

"These awards are a symbol of how far we've come as a club," said Ngoma.

"My teammates were all superb last season and give me extra motivation. Without them this

wouldn't have been possible."

The 27-year-old player started his football career playing for amateur clubs in Hammanskraal before playing for the University of Pretoria in 2008.

After four years with the students, he got his big break.

He was signed by Soweto giants Orlando Pirates in 2012.

He started to flourish when he joined Cape Town City in 2014.

Last season, he scored seven goals and made 16 assists in all competitions.
