



# Eagles eye another win

ROYAL Eagles will be gunning for a second successive league victory when they host Tshakhuma Tsha Madzivhandila (TTM) at Harry Gwala Stadium this afternoon.

With just five victories to their name this season, the club finds themselves 24 points adrift at the bottom of the table and just three from safety.

The well-funded franchise head into this game oozing with confidence following their win over Real Kings courtesy of a lone strike from veteran forward Mame Niang a week ago, and coach Roger Skhakhane's charges know that nothing less than three points will do this afternoon.
