“Grand strategy and leadership: prospects for the next 20 years of democracy”

presented by Prof Nick Binedell

South Africa's prosperity and stability in the next 20 years of democracy will depend on the choices we make. These choices are reflected at personal, organisational and national levels and in the rapidly changing world in which we live. It is vital that the rate of change is progressive, impactful and coherent.

The talk will explore the field of 'grand strategy', by which we mean a holistic and comprehensive way of looking at strategy and leadership and South Africa's prospects in the next 20 years.

What is self-evident is that South Africa has a significant quantum of latent social and economic potential which will need to be energised and organised in order for us to create a better life for all.

The talk will explore the universal and timeless relevance of the idea of strategic leadership and will analyse contemporary South Africa and the realistic prospects for our future.

Prof Nick Binedell is Dean of the Gordon Institute of Business Science (GIBS). He started his professional life in the mining and manufacturing sectors in sales and general management within the Barlow Rand Group. Prof Binedell has been a lifelong student of business strategy and leadership. He has over the past 30 years focused his career on the area of business education; bringing his personal insights, experience as a general manager and business acumen to bear on the way South African leaders are equipped to compete in the dynamic world of business. He completed a PhD at the University of Washington in Seattle, an MBA at the University of Cape Town and a Bachelor of Commerce at Rhodes University. Nick's journey at the helm of GIBS began in 1998 when he was approached to establish a new business school focused on meeting the individual and corporate needs of business in South Africa.

Suid-Afrika se voorspoed en stabiliteit oor die volgende 20 jaar van demokrasie sal deur die keuses wat ons uitoefen, bepaal word. Hierdie keuses word op persoonlike, organisatoriese en nasionale vlakke asook in die snel veranderende wêreld waarin ons woon, weerspieël. Dis noodsaaklik dat die tempo van verandering progressief, treffend en saamhangend sal wees.

Die lesing verken die terrein van 'n 'grootse strategie', 'n term wat betrekking het op die holistiese en omvattende manier waarop strategie en leierskap en Suid-Afrika se vooruitsigte oor die volgende 20 jaar beskou moet word.

Suid-Afrika het vanselfsprekend 'n noemenswaardige hoeveelheid latente sosiale en ekonomiese potensiaal wat bekrag en georganiseer sal moet word ten einde 'n beter lewe vir almal daar te stel.

Die lesing verken die universele en tydlose tersaaklikheid van die begrip 'strategiese leierskap' en ontleed ook die hedendaagse Suid-Afrika en die land se realistiese toekomsverwagtings.

Prof Nick Binedell is Dekaan van die Gordon Institute of Business Science (GIBS). Sy professionele lewe het in die myn- en vervaardigingssektore in verkope en algemene bestuur binne die Barlow Rand-groep begin. Prof Binedell is 'n lewenslange student van sake, strategie en leierskap. Vir die afgelope 30 jaar spits hy sy loopbaan toe op sakeopvoeding en laat geld hy sy persoonlike insigte, ervaring as algemene bestuurder en al sy sakekennis in die manier waarop Suid-Afrikaanse leiers toegerus word om in die dinamiese sakewêreld te kan meeding. Hy het 'n PhD aan die Universiteit van Washington, Seattle behaal, 'n MBA aan die Universiteit van Kaapstad en 'n BCom aan Rhodes-universiteit. Nick se reis aan die stuur van GIBS het in 1998 begin toe hy genader is om 'n nuwe sakeskool te open wat op die bevrediging van Suid-Afrikaanse ondernemings se individuele en korporatiewe behoeftes toegespits is.

Polelo e tla utolla lehlakore la Lenaneokgoboko, moo re bolelago ka mokgwa wa kakaretšo le wa botlalo ge go lebelelwa lenaneo le boetapele le dikgopolo tša Afrika Borwa mo mengwageng ye 20 yeo e tlogo.

Seo se lego pepeneneng ke gore Afrika Borwa e na le bo bokgoni bjo bogolo bjo bohlokwa bja leago le ekonomi bjo bo hlokago go maatlafatšwa le go beakanywa gore go dirwe bophelo bjo bokaone go batho ka moka. Polelo e tla utolla dikgopolo tša kakaretšo tšeo di sa fetogego le tša maleba tša lenaneo la boetapele le thipollo ya Afrika Borwa ya sebjalebja le dikgopolo tša nnete tša bokamoso bja rena.
