INFORMATION PROGRAMME

A very warm and friendly welcome to the Faculty of Education.

This document serves to provide you with information regarding your first weeks at the University of Pretoria. Also see the separate **Orientation Programme**, from 29 January – 2 Februarry 2018, that you must attend on Groenkloof Campus.

Students who have been allocated a space in residence may move in as from Friday, 26 January 2018. Residence information have been communicated with you already.

Lectures commence on Monday, 5 February 2018. The syllabus of the BEd programmes and the lecture time table will be discussed with you during the course of the Orientation week. You are advised, to register online as from 08 January 2018.

Please download the programme information and bring to the Orientation week that will take place during the week of 29 January - 2 February 2018.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

➤ Registration: Online registration for 1st year students open on 10 January 2018. All undergraduate students must register before 30 January 2018. If you are experiencing problems with the online registration process, you can phone, 012 420 5347, or send an email to: registration@up.ac.za, or register before 30 January 2018 on LC de Villiers, Sports Campus of the University of Pretoria.

➤ Contracts: All first year students have to upload signed contracts on the Student Portal. If not done yet, the original signed document can be submitted at LC de Villiers, Sports Campus before registration can take place. The Sports Campus at LC de Villiers will be open from 10 January 2018 – 09 February 2018.

> Fees payable prior to registration:

Residence deposit: R5 700 Registration fees: R5 000 International levy: R2 700

> Registration fee:

You will not be able to register online unless your registration fee of R5 000 has been paid. Please note that the full registration fee needs to be paid and that no arrangements can be made to pay the registration fee in instalments. If you qualify for NSFAS or any bursary that will exempt you from the registration fee, please visit the university web page: www.up.ac.za/feesand-funding.

Bursary holders:

Bursary holders must submit proof of the bursary award at the Sports Campus at LC De Villiers, or send via email to ssc@up.ac.za in order to clear the financial block on the student's record. Please note that a student remains responsible for the student account if the bursary sponsor does not pay the account.

There is a minimum clearance period of 5 days before the payment becomes effective and a student will be able to register.

> Proof of registration:

You are only regarded as a registered student once your proof of registration appears on the portal. The payment of a deposit, an initial payment or tuition fee does not constitute registration.

International students:

International students must submit copies of their passports, study visas and medical aid together with the international form at the Sports Campus at LC De Villiers, before they will be allowed to register.

Student card:

After registration, a student must obtain a student card at the Sports Campus at LC De Villiers, as soon as you are registered. Proof of registration is required.

See the orientation programme also posted on the Faculty's webpage with this document. for your scheduled sessions, according to your specific BEd programme. **You must attend all sessions scheduled from 29 January – 02 February 2018 on Groenkloof Campus, c/o George Storrer- and Leyds Streets, Faculty of Education, University of Pretoria.**

Please note that some subjects have Gr 12 subjects passed with a specific result as a prerequisite, e.g. Mathematics.

> Please note that the online registration link in the UP Student Centre will be available to first-year students from 08 January 2018.

> Final 2018 NSC Grade 12 Results:

Conditionally admitted students should note that the University of Pretoria will be processing the final 2017 Grade 12 results from 5 to 6 January 2018. Please access your portal (MyTuks Login), from 8 January 2018 to confirm your final admission status. The University of Pretoria opens on 08 January 2018 for online registration. If you cannot register online you can visit LC de Villiers Sports Campus from 10 January 2018 for assistance with registration.

> Online registration guidelines:

Step 1: Login to the University portal, click on the UP Student Centre link and check whether you have any holds on your record. The holds refer to your contract, ID document,

or Gr 12 results outstanding, that need to be submitted before you will be allowed to register.

- > Step 2: GO to the University of Pretoria's web page: http://www.up.ac.za/online-registration.
- Step 3: Watch the video to get specific instructions on how to use the online registration program.
- > Step 4: Print your proof of registration.
- Step 5: Collect your student card on the Sports Campus, LC de Villiers before Friday 2 February 2018.
