Reflexivity in Qualitative Research

Reflexivity involves looking at the influences on our research, influences that arise from our own values, beliefs, and theoretical frames. The researcher's reflexive stance determines how he/she conducts research, relates to participants, and represents them in writing. Reflexivity involves looking at all of the personal and epistemological influences that the researcher brings to the research process. In this session, the topic of reflexivity will be discussed with specific examples from studies conducted with women from the Muscogee (Creek) Indian tribe, who are members of one of the tribes of indigenous peoples of the United States.
