Final year project title: Detailed analysis of jigging methods

Background: Powder coating area

Wispeco Aluminium is a dynamic manufacturing company situated in Alrode in the south of Johannesburg. Customers have two surface finishing options after the extrusion process. The two surface finishing options include a powder coated or an anodised finish. Powder Coating can be any colour depending on the preference of the customer. The powder coating plant consists of 3 automated coating lines and one manual line. The aluminium extrusions are mounted onto a moving conveyor with jigs before the extrusions run through a spray booth and into the oven.

Project Scope Definition

Jigging forms an integral part of the powder coating process but doesn't really add value to the product. Jigging and off-jigging is a time-consuming process that is performed manually.

Tasks:

- Perform work studies and time studies on jigging process
- Identify difficult work methods
- Perform an in-depth analysis of jigging methods
- Perform an in-depth analysis of different jigs
- Link types of jigs with various profiles
- Research latest jigging methods, jig materials and jig profiles
- Research opportunity for vertical powder coating (latest technology)
- Propose various new methods and jig profiles

Deliverables:

- Time studies and work studies
- Detailed jigging analysis
- New technology research

Project aim: Increase productivity and throughput by decreasing time spent on jigging and off-jigging.
