Bipolar and Field Effect Transistor (FET) amplifier design: bias and frequency response of small signal loaded single stage, multistage, differential stage, and feedback amplifiers. Communication electronics: RF component modelling, two-port models for RF networks, matching networks, small signal narrowband RF amplifiers, RF oscillators.

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
