- 1. Relevant honours degree **or** relevant four-year bachelor's degree
- 2. A weighted average of at least 65% for the honours degree **or** a weighted average of at least 65%\* for the final-year of the four-year bachelor's degree
- 3. Psychology passed at final-year level. In the case of mature students, selected Psychology modules are specified in order to meet the admission requirements
- 4. Practical audition or portfolio
- 5. Interview
- 6. Written application form

Note: \*If targets are not met, applicants with less than 65% may be considered. Those who acquired an average of less than 65% and those who obtained a bachelor's degree at another institution may have to sit for a written examination and/or submit practical work to the satisfaction of the programme manager with the approval of the Dean. Eligibility for admission will depend on pre-screening.
