- The application form must be fully completed.
- Certified copy of a valid South African Identity Document
- Attachment of the certified Grade 12 Certificate & Highest Tertiary Qualification (if progressing student)
- Proof of physical address (home) document: A letter from the Traditional Authority for those residing from the villages and a letter from the Municipality Offices for those of Town/Townships / Farms (not statement of account, e.g. water bill, etc).
- Attach proof of income for both parents (If there is one parent or none, provide proof with affidavit signed by commissioner and proof of income for the guardian). (NB: In case of deceased parents(s), also attach copy of Death Certificates)
- Proof of enrolment or provisional acceptance letter from the Higher Education Institutions. It is compulsory to submit the University Acceptance / Admission Letter and the end of year Results (Matric and Tertiary).
