Eligibility

To apply you must be a citizen of (or hold refugee status in) a [Commonwealth country](#) other than the country hosting the award.

You must have completed an undergraduate degree at a 2:1 equivalent level

Prospective applicants must ensure they apply to the UP concurrently while applying for the QECS scholarship. Ensure you identify a supervisor at UP and a research topic during the application process.

Make sure that you have the following documentation to upload to your application:

- High school certificate
- Undergraduate transcript (and graduation certificate)
- Two references – preferably academic
- Passport
- Proof of English language ability if English is not your first language
