Objectives and Scope of the Bursary Scheme

The objectives of the bursary scheme are to provide educational assistance for prospective candidates studying towards a B.Comm (CA stream) degree up to Honours level. The scheme shall provide bursaries from **1st year B.Comm(CA stream) students** at approved universities in South Africa.

Extent of assistance

The value of bursaries will be defined from time to time, and will be based on the cost of:



Full tertiary registration and tuition costs



Residence fees that include meals, or if the bursar chooses to live privately, a generous living out allowance.



Book allowance



A personal allowance for the period that the bursar is at the tertiary institution.



A once-off computer allowance.

Bursary Allocation Criteria

Bursaries will be allocated on the basis of a balanced consideration of the following factors:



Academic performance: Applicants will be granted a bursary to study at a University only if he/she obtains at least an aggregate mark of 65% with Mathematics above 70% in matric.



Financial need







No current financial assistance



A selection process include interviews and psychometric assessment.

Conditions / Obligations

-  The granting of a bursary applies from 1st year full-time B.Comm (CA stream) to Honours level
-  Compulsory annual salaried vacation employment at the company during June/July or December /January is a condition for bursars.
-  Assistance will only be provided for the normal duration of the specific course.
-  Assistance will be provided on a year-to-year basis and bursaries will be renewed only if performance of bursars are satisfactory.
