- Outstanding debts for previous years of study will not be covered by the bursary
- The applicant should be admitted for registration at an accredited South African university
- Existing students who are not promoted to the next year of their study and/or have failed more than half of the modules will not be considered.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Letter of acceptance from the university for grade 12 learners.
- Academic pass in grade 12 with Mathematics and Physical Science both at 60% or higher is required.
- Limpopo residents will be given first preference
- Females and people with disabilities are encouraged to apply

- Certified copy of South African Identity Document
- Certified copy of proof of income for guardian/parents
- Admission letter from the university or College in any of the fields indicated above.
- Full academic history/records for students already at tertiary institution.
