participating universities.



Students will carry out process research projects
on topics like wood fibre beneficiation, recycled
fibre, process waste, energy or water efficiency,
and biofuels.



Participation may lead to employment as
an engineer-in-training at PAMSA member
companies.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

To apply, you must:

- Be a final-year BEng/BSc Chemical Engineering student at a registered South African university or a graduate.
- Have a minimum 60% average in your final year.
- Have completed your studies in five years or less.
- South African citizenship is preferred.
- Submit a CV, academic transcripts, letters of reference, and motivation.

Applications that do not meet the above criteria will not be considered.
