- Complete applications are sent to the host institution for verification before being forwarded to the NRF for further processing. (**Full Online process**)
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Applications must meet the eligibility criteria to be considered (please refer to Framework Document found on the UP website at <a href="www.up.ac.za/funding">www.up.ac.za/funding</a>)

- Full Official University Transcripts (results of Bachelor degree to date) (Certified)
- Disabled students to upload medical certificate (Required)
- Proof of NSFAS funding (if applicable)
- 2019 Proof of Honours registration only awarded applicants will require to do this in 2019.
- Curriculum Vitae and Matric results NOT required (only required documents must be submitted)

UP students can access their own student invoice from their UP student portal in order to show proof of NSFAS or other UP funding received during their Bachelor level studies.
