For example, if you do not have a student loan, you will not be required to submit supporting documentation for a student loan. The applicable documentation will be clear once you begin completing the application form.

Certified Copy of your ID (or passport) document	
Certified copy of your full academic transcript, including final results	
for 2025.	
If applicable, supporting documentation of your annual income. For	
example, a payslip, bank statements, proof of employment letter with	
salary details, affidavit, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation of any bursaries/awards/	
scholarships that you will continue to receive in 2026. For example,	
scholarship, bursary and/or award letters, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation of your student loan. For	
example, student loan balance statement, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation for the income status of your	
main guardian. For example, a pay slip, bank statement, proof of	
employment letter with salary details, affidavit, SASSA grant receipt,	
death certificate, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation for the income status of your	
secondary guardian. For example, a pay slip, bank statement, proof of	
employment letter with salary details, affidavit, SASSA grant receipt,	
death certificate, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation for any other persons	
contributing to your tuition fees. For example, confirmation of support	
letter, affidavit, etc.	
If applicable, supporting documentation of any bursaries/awards/	
scholarships that you have already been awarded for 2026. For	
example, scholarship, bursary and/or award letter, etc.
