DSTI-NRF Postgraduate Student Funding for 2026 - apply now!

Are you planning to start a Master's or Doctorate in 2026 in a NITheCS field of science?

If you achieved at least 65% in your previous degree, you may be eligible for student funding. Successful applicants will be funded either at Full Cost of Study (FCS) or Partial Cost of Study (PCS).

The FCS funding will be awarded to South African citizens and Permanent Residents who are:

- financially needy (i.e. those whose combined household family income is R350 000 per annum or less), or
- living with a disability, or
- exceptional academic achievers.

The **PCS funding** will be awarded to 5% of international students, including South African citizens and Permanent Residents who cannot be funded under FCS but meet other minimum requirements.

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Consult with your current or prospective supervisor about funding before submitting your application.

- 3. Apply via the NRF portal quote the NITheCS UID code 65212.
- 4. Complete NITheCS' <u>tracking form</u> to notify us of your submission, so we can monitor the progress of applications in the NITheCS fields.
