6. RESEARCH HIGHLIGHTS

2011- present: The focus of my research work is eResearch, Open Science, Open Research, Research Data Management (RDM), citizen science, open innovation, collaborative research and virtual research environments (digital ecologies). As such aspects such as open scholarship, repositories, digitisation, new scholarly communication models, and mobile services all need to be researched in detail.

2013 We conducted research into the data management practices in place at the CSIR. I have also completed research on the data citation practices within the South African research community as a part of a larger international task team endeavour. We completed extensive practical continued professional development with Honns-level interns in collaboration with the University of Pretoria.

2007-2010 The practices and systems to inform the cross-CSIR policy and implementation plan for records management. Also investigated the organisation's readiness to participate in and support virtual research. Collaborating in national projects to investigate digital curation.

2006 – 2007 Virtual Research Environment: A conceptual model to provide malaria researchers in South Africa with a virtual environment that would support and enable their research needs - across institutional boundaries.

2005 – 2006: Project leader for a research team that investigated and made recommendations regarding the CSIR's Human Capital Development Strategy.

2004 - 2005 SARIS project: The initiative set out to investigate more equitable access to electronic information resources but exposure to the international trends led to the development of a holistic framework for information service delivery for virtual/electronic research.

2004: Investigated the need for and the implications of implementing (human) competency based performance management for the CSIR. The process was not implemented due to technology constraints and the associated costs to develop the infrastructure.

2003-2005: Conducted research into the requirements for the establishment of learnerships at the CSIR. This led to the facilitation of two Department of Science and Technology-sponsored projects. The first related to Ecological Informatics (as a team member) the second to a programme in Disaster Management (project leader).
