Applications are invited from *outstanding young post-graduate students* who excel academically, demonstrate leadership, are committed to making a difference in the world, and have the energy to fulfil their ambitions.

Four Scholarships are available for South African residents in general; one for KwaZulu-Natal; and one for the alumni of each of the following schools: Diocesan College, Paul Roos

Gymnasium, St Andrew's College and South African College School. Applications from past pupils of identified partner schools are also invited. These are: Bishops: LEAP 1, St Cyprians, Herschel and St George's; Paul Roos: Rhenish and Bloemhof; St Andrew's : Diocesan;

SACS: Sans Souci and Rustenburg.

There is a further Scholarship available for residents of Botswana, Lesotho, Malawi, Namibia and Swaziland (BLMNS).

Candidates must be at least 19 and younger than 25 years at 1 October 2017. This age limit has been extended by three years for MBChB applicants who are doing their medical internship.

The Trust covers all costs, including university and college fees, and travel to and from Oxford.
