

SHORT BIO

Gert Jacobus Steyn (*1962), completed doctorates in Bible Languages (Stellenbosch) and in New Testament (Pretoria). He lectured at Unisa (1987-1990), the Federal Theological Seminary (1992-1993), the Universities of Johannesburg (1994-2003) and Pretoria (2003-2017), and since 2017 at the *Theologische Hochschule Ewersbach* (Germany). He was Principal of the Theological Education by Extension College of Southern Africa (1993-2000) and Departmental Head of New Testament Studies at the University of Pretoria (2010-2017). He successfully supervised 39 Masters' students and 21 Doctorates.

Steyn specializes in early Judaism (especially Septuagint Studies and Philo of Alexandria) and in early Christianity (especially Hebrews and Luke-Acts). He authored 196 scholarly publications in English, German and Afrikaans – which includes 7 books, encyclopaedic entries and Bible Translations.

Steyn is a founding and executive member of the Septuagint Society of South Africa (LXXSA), member of the IOSCS and SBL, former President and Secretary of the NTSSA, and an invited member of the prestigious international *Studiorum Novi Testamenti Societas* since 1999. He served as external reviewer for several Theological institutions across Africa and in Germany, as well as for research projects of the European Science Foundation, *Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft* (DFG), and the Alexander von Humboldt Stiftung. He is a research associate at the *Kirchliche Hochschule Wuppertal*, member of the *Arbeitskreis für evangelikale Theologie* (AfeT), and representative for Germany on the Theological Committee of the International Federation of Free Evangelical Churches.

Research awards received by Steyn included, amongst others, the Alexander von Humboldt, D.A.A.D., National Research Foundation (B-Rating) and University of Pretoria Exceptional Academic Achiever's award.
