

Language modules

The ECE programme consists of five 'Literacy Practices' modules that fall under the module code **JGL**. Three of the Five focus on home language development in the Foundation Phase. Currently students have a choice between English and Afrikaans. We are working on adding 3 more language choices in future: Sepedi, Setswana and isiZulu. Currently the modules are as follows:

- JGL 110/113 Focus on emergent literacy, children's literature, Gr. R language development and perceptual development.
- JGL 200/213 Focus on the teaching of reading and writing skills.
- JGL 311/313 Focus on the assessment and intervention of reading and writing in the Foundation Phase & data driven/Evidence-based teaching and learning.

The other two modules focus on the Teaching of a First Additional Language (FAL) in the Foundation Phase. The modules are as follows:

- **JGL 461** For this module, students have a choice between the following languages as a FAL:
 - Afrikaans, Sepedi, Setswana, isiZulu
- JGL 464 Focus is on the teaching of English as a FAL.
