The student has to attend lectures on Saturdays (due to COVID-19 restrictions and regulations – classes are held via ClickUP / Blackboard), submit assignments, sit for tests/examinations and submit a mini-dissertation on an approved theme. Students should note that work on the mini-dissertation must commence in the first year of study.

A. Requirements for admission

A candidate can be admitted if she/he holds one of the following qualifications:

- i. a BEd Hons degree / BEd (Postgraduate); or
- ii. an applicable Honours degree and a teacher's diploma; and
- iii. has achieved an average of at least 60% in the Honours or related examination.

B. Selection procedure

Selection is based on:

- i. meeting the minimum academic requirements required for admission;
- ii. previous academic performance;
- iii. applicable academic and/or teaching background;
- iv. availability of supervision for the required research project;
- v. proven academic potential which may include academic communication and computer application skills;
- vi. additionally, an interview may be requested;
- vii. the requirements of professional registration bodies:
- viii. Department of EMPS Supervision Capacity
- ix. the discretion of the Head of Department.

C. Duration

The programme must be completed within two years. Please note that classes will be presented ONLINE at least once a month from 8:00 - 16:00 (NMQ 800) and at least twice a month from 8:30 - 15:30 for the rest of the modules.
