#### Acting EMPS HOD Prof Hartell

- Extensive teaching and research experience in Higher Education
- Prior to EMPS: 4 years in the Department of Sociopedagogics, 6 years in Department of curriculum Studies, 10 years in the Department of Early Childhood Education and 3 years as Director for the Centre for Japanese Studies.
- 2012 he attained the Dean's award for BEd Re-curriculation and in
- 2014 he attained the Dean's award for Academic Leadership in Early Childhood Education.
- The University of Hiroshima invited him as a visiting professor in 2016 for 6 months.
- 2017 Prof Hartell received an award for Leadership and Appreciation from *The University* of Saints Malaysia for a comparative research project on teacher identity.
- His interests and expertise include: teacher professional development and identity, curriculum development, community and adult education and management as well as early childhood education
- Prof Hartell has successfully supervised 26 masters and 13 PhDs to completion
- He has over 30 publications and has published numerous articles on Black teacher identity and teacher professional development in South Africa.
- Earlier publications focused on the impact of HIV and Aids on adolescents in Childheaded households. His latest co-edited book in Afrikaans is titled:
  - Research for Early Career Academics.

- Purpose of the B.Ed (Hons) Education Management, Law and Policy (PRACTICAL & RESEARCH)
- B.Ed Hons EMPS package consists of 8 scheduled modules
  - as 2 modules per semester for part-time students and
  - four modules per semester for full time students.
- A research component (NMQ 745 & 755 WEM 781 project is compulsory)
- EMPS has 3 Research focus areas for B.Ed Hons
  - Policy,
  - Education Law and
  - Leadership & Management
- Group and individual supervision

## Honours Programmes - Dr P. Mukwambo

- 60% on paper for entry but more than 300 applications per year – staff capacity is limited, therefore
- 65% and above = consideration into MEd
- Research component is considered
- Please also consider doing the degree in Distance Education mode if you do not have the time
- DO well and excel each step of success leads you to qualify to access the next degree – M.Ed

- 1. Education Management and Policy Studies MEd EMLP full dissertation
- 2. Educational Leadership

  MEd EL Coursework mini dissertation
- All applications for MEd Studies subject to a rigorous selection process
- Require a complete academic record of all previous studies
- Submit a research concept note falls within the research foci of EMPS
- Computer literacy is strongly recommended for admission
- Duration of study and requirements for MEd degrees
- Students who register must complete their studies within **two years** after first registering for the degree.
- You will be assigned a supervisor based on the topic.
- Both MEds require the completion of 1 compulsory course work module NMQ800


#### MEd - Educational Leadership - Coursework - mini dissertation

- The completion of 4 compulsory modules.
  - NMQ800 Research Proposal Development same as for MED EMLP
  - HFE880 Human And Financial Management in Education
  - OWR880 Education Law.
  - LBL880 Leadership in Education.
- Modules are presented on <u>15 Saturday VIRTUAL /</u> <u>Contact sessions</u> between February and October ONLY in the 1st year of registration.
- FOR BOTH MEd & PhD Degrees After registration student and his/her supervisor will sign a Memorandum of Understanding, an agreement of expectations to set realistic goals and achieve those research milestones.

#### MEd - The purpose of NMQ 800 - Dr T. Calitz

- NMQ 800 is a research methodology module
- is designed to enable you to conceptualise, write and defend your research proposal
- You will attend five contact sessions where you will be instructed on the technical and theoretical aspects of your research proposal.
- Each contact session will focus on the structure and development of a different section of your research proposal.
- Attendance of each contact sessions is compulsory.
- NMQ culminates in a formal proposal defence





#### MEd - NMQ 801/800 Registration – Dr T. Calitz

- As per usual registration process:
  - 1. Students must register for NMQ 801\_Y1\_2022 if doing Full Research ME
  - 1. Students must register for NMQ 800\_Y1\_2022 if doing **Educational Leadership Coursework MEd**

- ONLY FOR Education Management and Policy Studies Department (EMPS):
- You will be given access to a ClickUP module called NMQ 800 EMPS 2022 by the NMQ lecturer.
- You do NOT have to register for this module.
- This is the EMPS Research Methods module for Semester 1

## 2 Doctoral Programmes - Dr K. Adeyemo

- 1. Education Management, Law and Policy
- 2. Education Policy Studies



- All applications for PhD studies subject to a rigorous selection process
- Complete academic record of all previous studies
- Submit a research concept note falls within the research foci of EMPS
- Computer literacy is strongly recommended for admission
- Attend the compulsory seminars and discussion classes.
- Duration of study and requirements for doctoral degrees
- Students who register for a doctorate must complete their studies within <u>three years</u> after first registering for the degree.



## Doctoral Programmes - Dr K. Adeyemo

- Submit a research proposal during the first year of registration and defend it successfully
- Submit a thesis for examination on a topic approved by the Dean on the recommendation of the Head of Department; and
- Submit proof of submission of an article issued by an accredited journal.
- Please note that only a selected number of students can be accommodated and that applications will be subject to a selection process.



## Manage your Supervisor - Prof Marishane


- Establish positive relationships with your supervisor and peers
- Seek regular contact with your supervisor. Make your time together productive.
- Follow up on items discussed in meetings keep your supervisor(s) informed of your progress and challenges
- Act as a "junior colleague" ask questions, advance ideas, show interest and support for shared goals
- Deal with problems sooner rather than later.
- Be proactive take responsibility for your own post grad experience
- Be your own "project manager" take initiative to get what you need from your supervisor
- Look for (or create) opportunities to help you get started and the key is communication
- Continue the mental transition from waiting for direction to charting your own course with guidance

#### Purpose

#### AdvDip (SLM)

- To empower and enable school leaders to develop the skills, knowledge and values needed to lead and manage schools effectively and efficiently,
- to work together in communities of practice and to contribute to improving the quality of delivery of education across the school system.

#### **BEd Hons (EMLP)**

• Improve and enhance educational professional development and practice of educators, trainers, facilitators and development practitioners in the classroom, school, university, technical and vocational education and training (TVET) colleges, the corporate world and in the wider community context.

## Entry requirements

#### AdvDip (SLM)

- A four-year Bachelor of Education degree,
- A former four-year Higher Diploma in Education
- A general first degree
- Diploma, plus a Postgraduate Certificate in Education,
- A former Postgraduate Higher Diploma in Education
- A former Advanced Certificate in Education (ACE) (Level 6 on the former eight-level NQF)
- A former Further Diploma in Education, which follows a former professional teaching qualification
- Recognition of prior learning (RPL) ACE (SML)
- Complete ICT training
- Have access to a computer, as well as to internet and sign a declaration stating this
- Enquire about the possibility of receiving financial support

#### **BEd Hons (EMLP)**

- A bachelor's degree and a teacher's diploma/Postgraduate Certificate in Education (e.g. BA + PGCE)
- A four-year composite degree in Education (e.g. BEd, BAEd)
- A holder of another M+4 teacher's diploma (i.e. former HED) - first complete a new Advanced Diploma at Level 7
- Complete ICT training
- Have access to a computer, as well as to the internet and sign a declaration stating this
- Enquire about the possibility of receiving financial support



#### Duration

#### AdvDip (SLM) & BEd Hons (EMLP)

- Minimum two (2) years (four exam opportunities)
- Maximum five (5) years (ten examination opportunities)
- Enroll at any time of the year. Date of enrolment determines the academic cycle
- Academic programme runs in six-month cycles: October to March and April to September

## Pedagogy

#### From Hybrid to E-learning mode of Instruction

- Three (3) x 1-day online sessions:
  - 1 day ClickUP training prior to start of block (compulsory to complete registration)
