How does the Distance Education application process work?

Duration of programmes:

- Minimum of 2 years (4 assessment sessions)
- Maximum of 5 years (10 assessment sessions)

Application periods:

There are 2 (two) registration cohorts per year

- 1 May until 28 August
 - Your first assessment session will be in April in the following year
- 1 November until 28 February of the following year
 - Your first assessment session will be in October

Application registration:

Students need to apply online.

- Please insure that you upload all your qualifications for final academic admission
- Internal applications are not allowed for the Distance Education programmes
- Your qualifications need to be completed before applying

Application registration process:

- 1. Student apply online
- 2. The DE Admin office will do the selection and check qualifications, the status will be indicated as DENY or ADMIT.
- 3. DENY status:
 - Student did not academically qualify
- 4. ADMIT status:
 - Student need to pay the registration fee before or on the closing date
- BEd Hons programmes R10 000
- AD programmes R7 500
- 5. Registration fee payment received:
- Student need to email the proof of payment to de.admin@up.ac.za
- The Admin Offices of Distance Education will pre-register the student

Application Pre-Registration:

- All modules will be activated in the minimum duration of 2 years
- After the final closing date communication will be emailed to all registered students regarding the online Orientation Session
