CAREER-ENHANCING SHORT COURSES

BRIEF DESCIPTION

This course is designed to equip urban practitioners connected with urban challenges with values, knowledge and skills, that will enable them to serve as incarnational and transformational urban leaders, able to read, reimagine and reconstruct their communities with many other people. The course will draw from stories of hope around the world.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Students will be enabled to:

- 1. Construct and articulate their own local urban theology.
- 2. Engage in critical readings of the city in terms of the systems and powers shaping it.
- 3. Develop a hopeful imagination for urban alternatives.
- 4. Develop an understanding of transformational urban development.
- 5. Integrate learning and translate it into a viable, smart and sustainable urban community/ministry praxis.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

This is a one year programme with five weeks of contact tuition. Written assignments are done after every intensive week to be submitted before the next intensive contact week. Each module will consist of theory, practical exercises, and in–depth reflection and integration of information.
