



Making a Father's Day Card: Activity






























Father's Day Card Activity

Help the learner create a personalised Father's Day card using the symbols to describe their dad.

What you will need:

- The card template
- The sheet with 10 descriptive symbols and text (e.g., kind, funny, handsome, etc.)
- Scissors, glue, crayons, markers (optional for decoration)

Steps:

- 1. Introduce the activity. Talk about Father's Day and why we celebrate fathers or father figures.
- 2. Show the child the card template and read the sentence starter, "Dad, you are..."
- 3. Present the symbols and help the child choose two symbols that describe their dad for the first sentence. Support their selection by commenting on their chosen symbol. Do the same with the second sentence.
- 4. Cut out the selected symbols and paste them into the blank blocks on the card. If necessary, assist the child.
- 5. Encourage the child to decorate the card, if they wish.
- 6. Read the card together with the child, pointing to the symbols.
