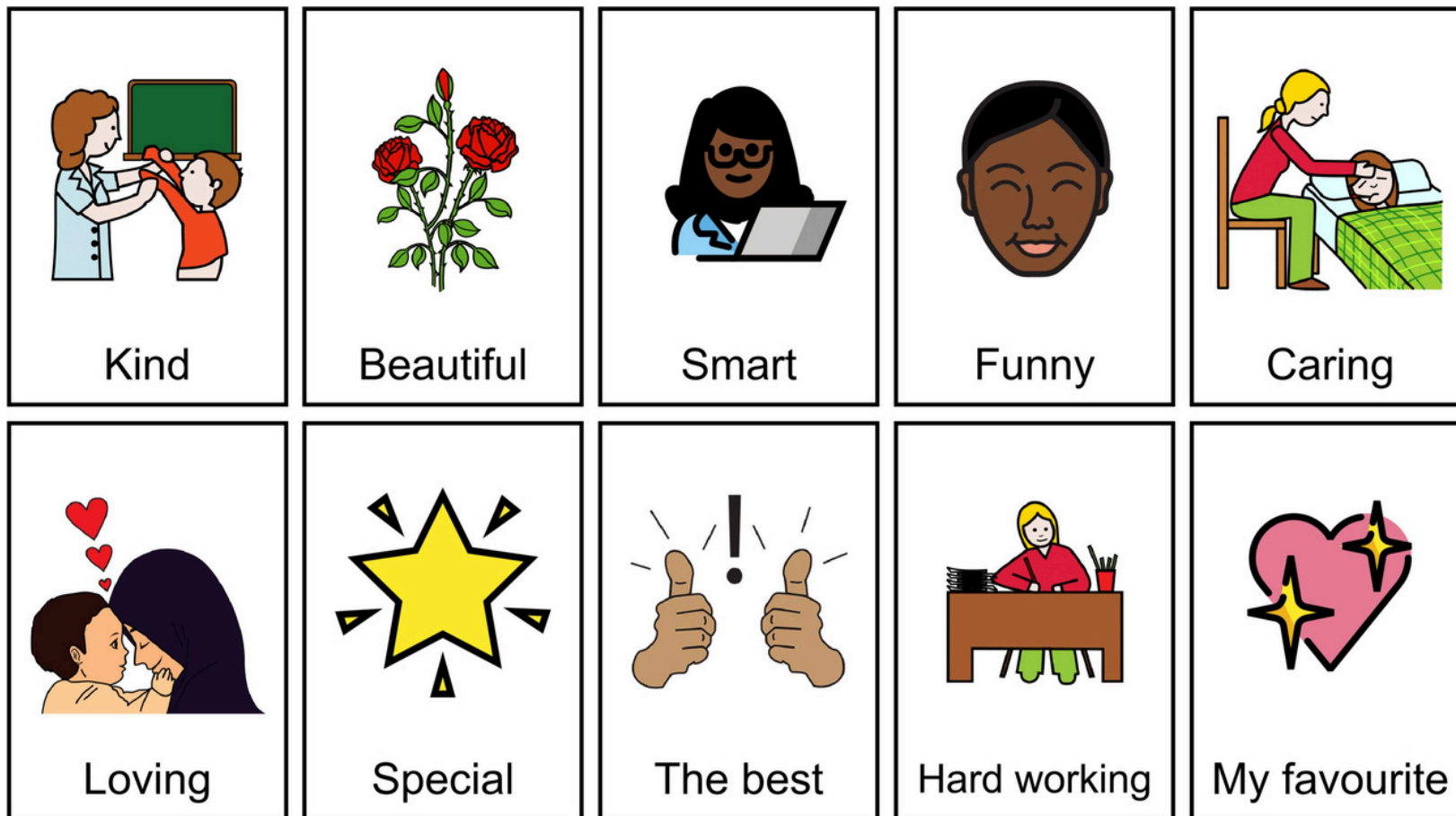

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



Mother's Day Card Activity

Help the learner create a personalised Mother's Day card using the symbols to describe their mum.

What you will need:

- The card template
- The sheet with 10 descriptive symbols and text (e.g., kind, funny, beautiful etc.,)
- Scissors, glue, crayons, markers (optional for decoration)

Steps:

1. Introduce the activity. Talk about Mother's Day and why we celebrate mothers or caregivers.
2. Show the child the card template and read the sentence starter, "Mum, you are.."
3. Present the symbols and help the child choose two symbols that describes their mum for the first sentence. Support their selection by commenting on their chosen symbol. Do the same with the second sentence.
4. Cut out the selected symbols and paste them into the blank blocks on the card. Assist the child if required.
5. Encourage the child to decorate the card if they wish.
6. Read the card together with the child, while pointing to the symbols.
