




We stand at a critical moment in Earth's history, a time when humanity must choose its future.




"To move forward we must recognize that in the midst of a magnificent diversity of cultures and life forms we are one human family and one Earth community with a common destiny". (Preamble).





History

The Earth Charter

On going international consultations were organized.

In March 1997 at the Rio+5
Forum, a first Benchmark
Draft of the Earth Charter
was released as a
"document in progress".



A fter numerous drafts and after considering the input of people from all regions of the world, the Earth Charter Commission came to consensus on the Earth Charter in March 2000, at a meeting held at UNE SCO head quarters in Paris.

The Earth Charter was formally launched in a special ceremony on 29 June at The Peace Palace in The Hague,

O ver the following five years, a form allendorsement campaign attracted over 2,000 organizational endorsements, representing millions of people, including numerous national and international associations, and ultimately global institutions such as IINF SCO and IIICN – The

Earth Charter International (ECI) is the organization that powers the Earth Charter global movement by providing information, networking, and educational opportunities to turn conscience into action.

The mission of E Cl is to contribute to the transition to sustainable ways of living on the planet.

Inspired by the Earth Charter, thousands of individuals and organizations around the world are part of the Earth Charter global movement. Most of them act independently, but they occasionally collaborate.

The ECI Secretariat functions as the coordinating hub for the worldwide movement. Based at the United Nations-mandated University for Peace in Costa Rica.




