Peter Case is a Professor of Organization Studies at the University of the West of England, UK, and adjunct Professor of Management and Organization Studies at James Cook University, Australia.

His research interests encompass organization theory, organization development and global healthcare. He has extensive experience of leading projects focussed on the organizational challenges of malaria elimination in the Greater Mekong Sub-region and southern Africa.

He served as a consultant to the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation-funded Malaria Elimination Initiative, advising on infectious disease programme management.

Prior to his work in the malaria space, Peter led food security projects funded by the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research. He has published widely in the fields of management, organization studies and public health, and serves as editor in chief of the Journal of Tropical Futures (SAGE).
