- NRF Extension Support (*for NRF Scholarship Holders – Masters and PhD ONLY*)
- NRF Doctoral TWAS (*for citizens and permanent residents of from developing countries on the African Continent and elsewhere*)
- NRF SASAC Doctoral (*for South Africans; Permanent Residents and limited % foreign nationals*)
