## School Uniform Shop

All school uniform is available from the uniform shop, except for the grey skirts/pants and the white school shirts. These can be bought from any reputable clothing retailer.
The shop is open on Fridays from 9:00 to 12:30.

## BOYS

## General Appearance

## Hair

Should at all times be kept clean and neat and should be cut in a manageable style.
No exaggerated hairstyles are permitted, including undercuts, pattern shaving, Mohicans, colouring, etc.
The following rules should be adhered to regarding the length of a boys' hair:

- Sides No longer than the top of the ear.
- Back: No longer than the top of the collar.
- Front: Hair may not hang in the eyes or be worn longer than the eyebrows.

Boys who do not comply with the hair regulations will have their hair cut at school by a teacher. A \#5 razor comb will be used for the sides, and \#8 for the top. The above rules regarding hairstyles are applicable from the first day of every term. No exception will be made.

## Beards

Boys must be clean-shaven at all times.
Sideburns may not extend below the centre of the ear.
Boys who do not comply with the beard regulations will be forced to shave at school.
Boys with a skin problem must submit a doctor's letter to the school.

## Nails

Must at all times be kept clean and short.
When the hand is viewed from the palm side, the tips of the nails may not be visible.

## Jewellery

No jewellery, including religious symbols such as crucifixes or beads of a symbolic nature, may be worn.

Watches are permitted.
Jewellery and clothing or shoes that are not part of the uniform may be confiscated and kept in the safe for two weeks.

## School Uniform

## Shoes

Only bona fide trainers or sport shoes are allowed. This excludes non-training, fashion shoes.

Shoes must be laced and the shoe laces must match the shoe.
Only secret socks, white socks or socks that match the colour of the shoe are allowed with daily uniform.

## Shirts, Shorts and Tracksuits

Only the official TuksSport High School uniform range may be worn.
No Tuks or sport specific shorts, shirts, jerseys or tracksuits may be worn.
Shorts and tracksuits must be worn in such a way that no underwear is visible at any time.
A short-sleeved white t-shirt may be worn under the golf shirt, but it may not be visible at any time.

## Beanies and Scarves

Only the TuksSport High School beanie and scarf may be worn. Beanies may not be worn inside any school venue, including class rooms and the hall.

## Formal School Uniform

The formal school uniform, to be worn every Wednesday, consists of:

- Grey school flannel pants
- White collared school shirt
- School tie
- School pullover
- School jersey
- School parka
- Black school shoes
- Grey school socks
- Black belt
- Blue TuksSport High School Blazer (Only compulsory for prefects and those learners who will represent the school at functions other than school functions - may be rented).

Please note: THE SCHOOL UNIFORM AND THE FORMAL UNIFORM ARE NOT TO BE MIXED. For example, the school jersey should not be worn with tracksuit pants, and the beanie should not be worn with formal uniform.

## GIRLS

## General Appearance

Hair
Should be kept clean and neat at all times.
Hair that reaches the bottom of the collar must be tied up.
Only black, red, navy or white hair accessories may be worn.
Fringes should be tied away if worn longer than the eyebrows.
No exaggerated hairstyles are permitted, including undercuts, pattern shaving, Mohicans, colour contrasts, etc.

## Make-up

Girls may not wear any make-up to school.

## Nails

Nails must be kept clean and neat at all times.
When the hand is viewed from the palm side, the tips of the nails may not be visible.
No coloured nail varnish is allowed.

## Jewellery

Girls may wear only one set of earrings.
Only small gold, silver or diamond studs or rings are allowed.
Ring-type earrings may be no larger than a 10c piece.
No other pieces of jewellery, including religious symbols such as crucifixes or beads of a symbolic nature, may be worn.
Watches are permitted.
Jewellery and clothing or shoes that are not part of the uniform may be confiscated and kept in the safe for two weeks.

## School Uniform

## Shoes

Only bona fide trainers or sport shoes are allowed. This excludes non-training, fashion shoes.

Shoe laces must match the shoe.
Only secret socks, white socks or socks that match the colour of the shoe are allowed with daily uniform.

## Golf shirts, Skirts and Tracksuits

Only the official TuksSport High School uniform range may be worn.

No Tuks or sport specific shorts, shirts, jerseys or tracksuits may be worn.
A short-sleeved white t-shirt may be worn under the golf shirt, but it may not be visible at any time.

## Beanies and Scarves

Only the TuksSport High School beanie and scarf may be worn. Beanies may not be worn inside any school venue, including class rooms and the hall.

## Formal School Uniform

The formal school uniform, to be worn every Wednesday, consists of:

- Grey school slacks or grey A-line school skirt. The length of the skirt must not be more than 4 fingers above the knee when pupil kneels.
- White collared school shirt
- School tie
- School pullover
- School jersey
- School parka
- Black school shoes
- Black tights (in winter) or white school socks (in summer).
- For formal functions, such as accolades, girls are allowed to wear Blackmail stockings.
- Blue TuksSport High School Blazer (Only compulsory for prefects and those learners who will represent the school at functions other than school functions - may be rented).

Please note: THE SCHOOL UNIFORM AND THE FORMAL UNIFORM ARE NOT TO BE MIXED. For example, the school jersey should not be worn with tracksuit pants, and the beanie should not be worn with formal uniform.
