

Prof Madeleine Stiglingh completed her B.Rek Accounting, B.Rek Accounting (Hons) and M.Com (Taxation) degrees at the former University of Potchefstroom (current NWU) where she not only received these qualifications *cum laude*, but was the best student in all three of these degrees. Her D.Com qualification received the Deneys Reitz award for the best national thesis in Taxation. She is also a qualified Chartered Accountant (CA(SA)) and Master Tax Practitioner MTP(SA).

Professor Stiglingh's research interest acknowledges the interdependence of financial and tax related reporting and stakeholder behavior. She has successfully supervised/co-supervised more than 50 M.Com students and six PhD students to completion, of which two have been awarded the national winner in the Norton Rose Fullbright National Tax Thesis Competition.

After her employment at both the Auditing and Taxation Departments of PriceWaterhouseCoopers, she was appointed at the University of Pretoria in 1997. She was the Chair of the School of Financial Sciences in 2005, Head of the Department of Taxation from 2004 - 2015 and Head of the Department of Accounting from 1 January 2016 – 31 December 2019. For the period 2014 – 2019 four Teaching and Learning teams in Departments where she was the head, received the Laureate for Teaching and Learning award from the University of Pretoria. She has also been instrumental in fostering a productive research culture amongst staff and students, resulting in a meaningful contribution towards the Faculty of Economic and Management Science's overall research output.
