What we will do:

In an attempt to raise funds for the Lizette Kotze Student Support Fund (see attached), some of the FRK 705 lecturers (Denice Pretorius, Tania Tomes and Rieka von Well) will be hiking the [Wille Willemien Camino](#) in the Eastern Free State, from 28 August to 2 September 2024. The total distance that will be covered over 4 days is approximately 86 kilometers.

What you must do immediately (or sooner than later):
