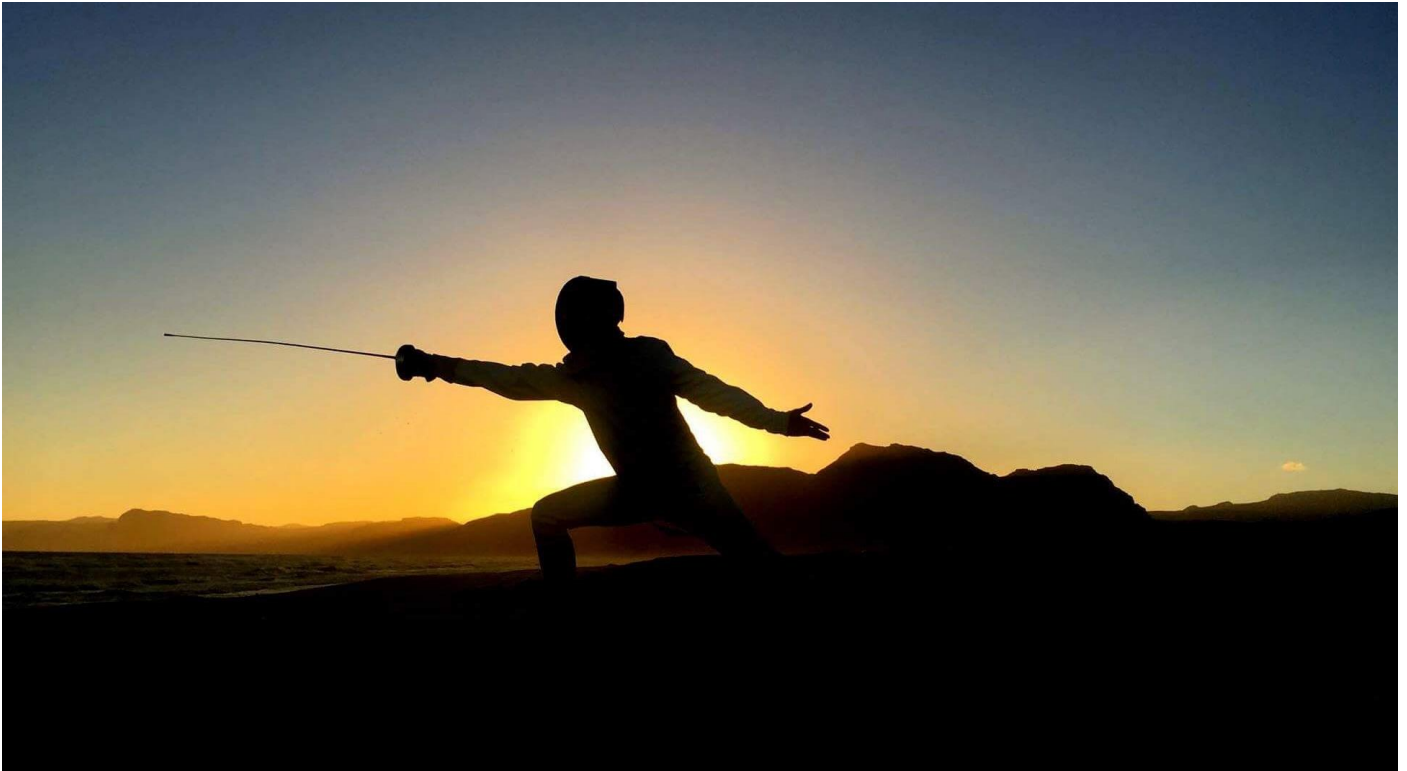


TuksFencing: Fast moving - Forward thinking



The sport of fencing is governed by the rules of the International Fencing Federation which stipulates biannual age groupings in this sport, i.e. U11, U13, U15, U17, U20 and Seniors. The SA National Youth Championships comprised all these categories, except Seniors. Competitions consist of pools of up to 8 fencers (round-robin), where the highest ranking fencers per pool compete in direct elimination.

In addition, fencing comprise of 3 disciplines (weapon categories). TuksFencing has focussed its development specifically in the “Epee” weapon category, which is the traditional duelling sword. Notwithstanding, TuksFencing competes in the other two disciplines as well; being “Foil” (light thrusting weapon) and “Sabre” (light slashing weapon), with valid target areas as below:
