## SAFPU meeting Chiefs star over R5 000 wage debacle

The South African Football Play-ers Union (SAFPU) will meet with Kaizer Chiefs regarding Bruce Bvuma this week to discuss the way forward following the news that he is currently only earning R5 000 per month.
