



# Mosala joins FS Stars as Congo keeper gets chopped

FREE State Stars have released Congo international goalkeeper Christoffer Mafoumbi and signed former University of Pretoria coach Sly Mosala as assistant coach for the new season.

This was revealed yesterday by *Ea Lla Koto* general manager Rantsi Mokoena.

Mafoumbi was injured in pre-season training at the start of last season and only returned to action in January. His place was taken by the inform Thela Ngobeni who is on loan from Mamelodi Sundowns.

Said Mokoena: "We can't guarantee anybody a place so we decided to release Mafoumbi. But we are looking for a new keeper before the start of the season."

The Stars boss stressed that they were also keen to extend Ngobeni's loan. Said Mokoena:

"We are very interested in keeping Ngobeni for another season. We are in negotiations with Sundowns to keep him on board for another loan spell and hope that we

can come to an agreement with Sundowns."

Mokoena also confirmed that the club would not renew head coach Serame Letsoaka's contract

which expires at the end of the month.

He said: "We are busy finalising signing a new coach. I hope to make an announcement later this week."

However, Mokoena refused to comment on speculation that he will bring Black Leopards Belgium born coach Jean Loscuito on board.

But as reported in *SunSport* on Monday, it is believed that Loscuito's future lies in Bethlehem with Stars and not in Thohoyandou with Leopards.
