#### TJA APPROVED PARTICIPATION EXEMPTIONS

Tshwane Judo acknowledges that judokas and members may have other commitments due to work, school activities or sometimes family emergencies or illness may occur. Consequently, Tshwane Judo will implement a minimum attendance of certain events as to qualify for participation in for example the TJA Trials or South African Open.

Exemptions should be applied for by members through their respective clubs and shall be considered by the TJA Executive Members on a case-by-case basis, i.e., exemption is not automatically granted. Clubs should direct the request for participation exemption to the TJA Technical Chairperson, with the TJA Secretary and TJA Chairperson copied in the mail.

Accordingly, the TJA Executive Members shall also consider granting exemption of participation in the following cases:

- Due to injury or illness, as supported by a medical certificate.
- Due to compulsory school or university activities, as supported by a letter from the respective governing body.
- Due to school or university examinations, as supported by an official exam table issued by the respective governing body.

Attendance or participation in other sporting activities (e.g., wrestling, rugby etc) will not be considered by the TJA Executive Members unless it represents a compulsory school or university activity.

Attendance or participation in other sporting activities on the day of the TJA event, when participation exemptions were granted due to injury, illness or school/ university examinations shall be considered a breach of the conditions under which the exemption is granted.

Note, should the TJA Executive Committee be made aware of or become aware of any dishonesty from a member of whom received participation exemption and breached the conditions under which the participation exemption has been granted, shall be subject to disciplinary action.



#### **TJACADEMY QUALIFICATION 2025 RULE**

Tshwane Judo will host a series of TJAcademy Days during the course of 1 January 2025 till 30 June 2025. The TJAcademy Days will serve as qualification to participate in the TJA SA Open and National Schools Trials.

For this period, Tshwane Judo will provide two (2) qualification events, being event #4 and #6. Accordingly, TJA Judokas who wish to participate in the TJA Trials (Event #11) **must attend a minimum of one (1) of the two (2) qualification events**.

**Failure to attend a minimum of one (1) qualification event** will result in the TJA Judoka **not being allowed to participate in the TJA Trials** (Event #10) and accordingly not qualify to participate in the Judo South Africa Open Championships and National Schools 2025.

All TJA Judokas who have qualified for participation in the Judo South Africa Open Championships and National Schools **must attend a minimum of three (3) out of four (4)** of the following TJA Squad Trainings:

- TJA Squad Training (Event #12) Mandatory
- TJA Squad Training (Event #13) Optional
- TJA Squad Training (Event #14) Optional
- TJA Squad Training (Event #15) Mandatory

#### **TJACADEMY QUALIFICATION 2026 RULE**

Tshwane Judo will host a series of TJAcademy Days during the course of 1 July 2025 till 30 June 2026. The TJAcademy Days will serve as qualification to participate in the TJA SA Open and National Schools Trials.

For this period, Tshwane Judo will provide four (4) qualification events being event #18 and #23 as well as two (2) events in the 2026 calendar year. Accordingly, TJA Judokas who wish to participate in the TJA Trials 2026 **must attend a minimum of three (3) of the four (4) qualification events**.



**Failure to attend a minimum of three (3) qualification events** will result in the TJA Judoka **not being allowed to participate in the TJA Trials 2026** and accordingly not qualify to participate in the Judo South Africa Open Championships and National Schools 2026.

### MASAKHANE TEAMS QUALIFICATION 2025 RULE

Tshwane Judo will host two (2) of TJAcademy Days that will serve as qualification to represent TJA in the Masakhane Team Events (Gauteng Tournaments) in 2025.

TJA Judokas who wish to participate in the Masakhane Team Events must attend the following TJAcademy Days respectively:

- TJAcademy Day (Event #6) for Masakhane Team Event Saturday, 15 March 2025
- TJAcademy Day (Event #18) for Masakhane Team Event Saturday, 13 September 2025

All TJA Judokas who have qualified must attend the following TJA Squad Trainings for the respective event:

- TJA Squad Training (Event #8) for Masakhane Team Event Saturday, 15 March 2025
- TJA Squad Training (Event #21) for Masakhane Team Event Saturday, 13 September 2025
