



Gauteng Jaguars earn crown again

THE Gauteng Jaguars lifted the Brutal Fruit Netball Premier League trophy for the second consecutive year after a 49-47 victory over the Western Cape Southern Stings at the University of Pretoria's Rembrandt Hall yesterday.

The last time these two teams met, in the first round of the tournament, the Jaguars claimed a comfortable 51-43 win, but it was a dramatically different encounter this time around, with so much more at stake.

Tshina Mdau was named player of the match for her efforts on wing defence for the Jaguars, while the Free State Crinums centre, Khanyisa Chawane, was named the player of the tournament.
