"It's an international women's conference – the leading women in sport around the world." explained Molokwane, adding that one of the conference speakers from Canada had attended Brutal Fruit Netball Premier League matches at Ellis Park Arena

"It's about women going to speak in a platform where women are free, talking to each other and giving each other advice on how to penetrate this domination of a man's world.

I'm talking about
big committees
that are controlling sport in the
world.

"If we stick together as women and we believe in each other, it's going to help us a lot. Networking, knowing what other women are doing in their countries to be where they are and how we can help each other.

each other up so
I think we will
lift each other up
in Botswana,"
said Molokwane.
