

# Netball SA chief Molokwane to network at World Conference

Meeting to take place in Gaborone

Netball South Africa announced yesterday that its president Cecilia Molokwane will attend the World Conference on Women in Sport this week.

Molokwane will be joined by

delegates from across the globe in Gaborone, Botswana, where the conference takes place from Thursday to Sunday.

"It's an international women's conference - the leading women in sport around the world," explained Molokwane, adding that one of the conference speakers from Canada had attended Brutal Fruit Netball Premier League matches at Ellis Park Arena at the weekend.

"We can't look forward to always going to conferences that are not women-related," she said.

"So we have to change our mindset to say this is women-related."

"It's about women going to speak in a platform where women are free, talking to each other and giving each other advice on how to penetrate this domination of a man's world."

"Look at your IOC [International Olympic Committee], predominantly men, look at your Commonwealth committee, predominantly men. I'm talking about big committees that are controlling sport in the world."

"If we stick together as women and we believe in each other, it's going to help us a lot. Networking, knowing what other women are doing in their countries to be where they are and how we can help each other."

"You become better by lifting each other up so I think we will lift each other up in Botswana," said Molokwane.

Meanwhile, the Netball Premier League action will continue this week with round two taking place at Ellis Park Arena, starting with a clash between the Gauteng Jaguars and the Limpopo Baobabs on Friday

Constitution	The constitution of the Chamber Committees will be at the discretion of the Accounting Authority of the SETA, subject to applicable legislation, regulations and policies.
Delegation	Chamber Committees act on delegation by the Board of the Transport SETA.

Each nomination must be accompanied by the CV and certified copies of the ID and qualifications of the nominee. Nominations must indicate the Chamber Committee for which the nominee is nominated.

Nominations must also indicate whether the nominee is nominated as a labour, business or government representative.
