The 2024 Summer Olympics is fast approaching and brings along a lot of excitement especially for several of our TuksRugby alumni. Since the inclusion of sevens rugby into the Olympic Games in 2016, the Blitzboks have participated in every Olympics and TuksRugby alumni, Impi Visser, will be preparing to attend his second Olympic Games. The Blitzboks road to qualification for the 2024 Paris Olympics was long and hard but the team managed to lock in their spot after winning the repechage tournament in Monaco end of June. For the Springbok Women 7s team however, the road to the Olympic Games has been a battle hard fought over many years.

After qualifying for the 2016 Olympic Games, the team did not compete and runners-up of the Africa qualification, Kenya, went in their place. In 2020, the same events occurred with our ladies again being refused participation despite qualification.

It is very evident that women's rugby in South Africa has been on the rise over the past two years and some may say this is the reason why finally after having qualified twice in the past, the ladies team has received the thumbs-up to participate this year.

With the Springbok Women's 7s team participating in the 2024 Paris Olympic Games for the first time ever, this is a



It is USSA season at the University and our teams are ready to go! The USSAs Rugby 15s Championship is an annual event for the men's team but this year will see the inclusion of the women as well, however they will be competing in the 10s format. The inclusion of the women hopes to bring about a USSA 15s competition for them in the future, with 10s being a format in which many universities can now compete in. This will allow the universities time to grow their player base while giving their current players the opportunity to compete this year.

With the excitement of 7s combined by the power of 15s, 10s or 10-a-side rugby is a variant of rugby in which teams are made up of 10 players, typically 5 forwards and 5 backs. Match time also differs with two 10 minute halves. The rules for the game are very similar to that of rugby 7s. However, unlike 7s rugby, 10s offer players of diverse skills, capabilities, and different levels of fitness the opportunity to continue to enjoy the game. The more traditional scrums and lineouts are part of the game whilst the fact that there is a bit



more space on the field, however, not too much as to expose the slower forwards on the defense line, makes this a very popular game for all levels of players. UP-Tuks men and women will compete in this year's USSAs Rugby tournament which will be taking place at Rhodes University in Grahamstown, Port Alfred. The competition will kick off 1 July and conclude 5 July.
