Co-Captain of the FNB UP-Tuks 1 team, Allister Williams, wants to leave the jersey in a better place... by winning the FNB Varsity Shield and restoring Tuks' place in the Varsity Cup competition.

Matriculant of the prestigious Paarl Boys High School, it is no surprise that Allister is a player who exhibits great leadership and talent on the field. Growing up in a family who loves rugby also cemented Allister's path towards rugby, he played cricket up to the age of 15 but by then the rugby bug had bit him and he then shifted his focus to only rugby.

Representing his high school from under 14 up to under 19, the natural



step for the young player was to play at a provincial level. He played for Western Province in the Grant Khomo Week at under 16 level and in the Craven Week at under 18 level. Allister also had his first taste of the green and gold when he represented the SA Schools A side in 2019.

It was no surprise when the young hooker was contracted by the Lions as soon as he left school. Allister played for the under 21 Lions team who then won the u21 Currie Cup in 2021.

With such an impressive CV, Tuks was not oblivious to this talented player. Allister realized as most players should that an education is just as important as a rugby career. He made his debut for UP-Tuks in 2022 against old rivals, Maties.


